Locustville Pond is a lovely pond in Hopkinton, RI used for recreation (swimming, fishing, boating) and hydroelectric power purposes. Its surface area is 83 acres (0.3 km²). It drains an area of 11.3 square miles (29 km²). Its depth range is < 3 to 12 feet (>1 to 3.7 m).

Date of origin of pond: Damming of Brushy Brook in 1814 (refurbished 1855)

Pond public access: RIDEM boat ramp (Sunset Street), gravel, 10 HP engine limit

Fish Species: Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass, Chain Pickerel, Yellow Perch, Channel Catfish, Brown Bullhead, Bluegill, Golden Shiner - LP is a RI designated trout waters via Brush Brook!
